## REVIEW AND RESCONDENDATIONS

 TAIAL DATA: The accused was tried at Dachau, Germany, during the period 7-8 August 1947, before a General Military Government Court.
 CHARGE AND FARTICULARS:

OnaRio: Ficiation of the Laws and Usages of War.

Particulars: In that Bernhard Schlade, a German national, did, at or near ISSAL, Germany, on or about 15 January 1945, wrongfully encourage, sid, shet and participate in the killing of four members of the United States Army, who were then and there quarant end surrendered prisoners of war in the sustedy of the then German Reich.

III. DATA AS TO ACCUSED: This accused was equitted (H 33).

IV. SUBMARY OF WINDSOF: About the middle of January 1945, four Associons coldiers, who were prisoners of war, were shot and billed by members of the SD at Issel, Germany, and their bodies thrown into the Mosel River. Accused SCHLAHP was 15 to 20 meters every from the scene at the time of the shooting. At the order of the SD man in charge, he dragged one of the deed bodies to the river bank (R 6, 7; P-2re 2s, 3s).

The Court had jurisdiction of the person of the accused and of the subject matter.
