2. EVIDENCE:

For the Prosecution: On or about May 1944, two unknown American fliers parachuted to earth approximately 50 to 100 meters apart in the vicinity of BLOFELD HESSEN, Germany (P-Ex 5). Karl HESS and Rudolf KUFER were among the first to arrive of the crowd that gathered (R 16). Neither of the two fliers offered resistance. HESS beat one flyer with a hoe with such severity that the flyer fell. KUFER beat the flyer in the face until he bled from his mouth (P-Ex 1, 4 and 5). KUFER then went over to the second flyer and beat him in the face with his fists (P-Ex 2 and 5). Both fliers were then led away.

This case was tried solely on affidavits on behalf of the Prosecution. The testimony contained in the affidavits was that one flyer was besten severely with a hoe by the accused Karl HESS and in the face with his fists by accused Rudolf KUFER so that the flyer fell to the ground bleeding from the mouth (Wilhelm ROTH P-Ex 3, Wilhelm SCHMIDT P-Ex 4). Hermann NICOLAY same testimony with respect only to accused HESS (P-Ex 6). Wilhelm FISCHER, (P-Ex 5) same testimony as to accused HESS. and that accused KUFER best the second flyer in the face with his fists. Both accused admitted beating the fliers (P-Ex 1 and 2).

For the Defense: Accused HESS admitted beating the flyer with a hoe but denied beating any other flyer (P-Ex 1) and explained that when he indicated with the hoe that he wanted the flyer to move, the flyer grabbed the hoe and pulled is away from the accused. Thereafter, when he got the hoe back the accused beat him (R 14). KUFER did not take the stand in his own behalf but admitted beating bot fliers in his pre-trial statement (P-Ex 2).

- 3. <u>JURISDICTION</u>: The Court was legally constituted and had jurisdiction of the persons of the accused and of the offenses.
- 4. COMMENTS: Examination of the entire record fails to disclose any error or omission which resulted in injustice to the accused.
- 5. CLEMENCY: There are no Petitions for Review nor Petitions for Clemency.
- 6. CONCLUSIONS:
 - a. It is recommended that the sentences be approved.
