

CRITERIA FOR STATEHOOD

As Part Of The Vision, United States Will Stand With The Palestinians And The International Community To Implement A Key Set Of Reforms To Prepare Them For Statehood And Reduce the Risk of a Failed State.

- 1. Building Credible Institutions Ministry Of Finance And Monetary Authority
- 2. A Fair Judiciary to protect property rights
- 3. Respect For Human Rights
- 4. Building The Capacity Of Palestinian Security Forces
- 5. Ending Payments To Terrorists And Modernizing The Social Welfare System
- 6. Creating A Culture Of Tolerance In Their Education System
- 7. Mutual Recognition
- 8. Ensuring Palestinian Control Over The Gaza Strip And The Disarmament Of Terrorists

OUR GOALS:



Give Palestinian People The Most Realistic Opportunity To Have Self Determination, Dignity, And A Pathway To A Better Life



To Allow All Muslims To Visit And Pray At The Haram Al-Sharif, Show The Mosque Is Safe, And Also Affirm The Special Role Of Jordan's King With Regard To The Muslim Shrines In Jerusalem



Get Parties To Negotiate A Realistic Compromise Based On Details Rather Than High Level Principles To Try To Bring An End To One Of The Longest Running Conflicts That Has Led To Substantial Instability In The Middle East
