## III - GENERAL ASSEMBLY: OVERALL VOTES

## VOTING COINCIDENCE WITH THE UNITED STATES

This section contains tables of the 87 Plenary votes that were recorded at the $65^{\text {th }}$ session of the UN General Assembly. Of the total 87 votes, the United States voted Yes 26 times ( 30 percent) and No 45 times ( 52 percent); it abstained on 15 votes ( 17 percent), and was absent for one.

All General Assembly members voted during the session. The United States voted No in Plenary more often than any other UN member, but did not vote No in isolation on any resolution, after doing so once in 2009 and 16 times in 2008.

The United States voted No with three other countries on two resolutions: with France, Israel, and the United Kingdom on Resolution 55; and with India, Israel, and Pakistan on a preliminary vote for Resolution 59.

The United States voted No with two other countries on eight occasions: with the Marshall Islands and Palau on Resolution 199; with France and the United Kingdom on Resolutions 49, 58, and 71; and with Israel and the United Kingdom on Resolutions 116, 117, 118, and 119.

The United States voted No with one other country twice: both times with Israel, on Resolutions 6 and 109. The only U.S. absence was on a preliminary vote for Resolution 71.

On non-consensus issues, i.e., those on which a vote was taken, the average overall General Assembly voting coincidence of all UN members with the United States in 2010 was 41.6 percent, increased from 39 percent in 2009. In 2008, voting coincidence was 25.6 percent, and in 2007 it was 18.3 percent.

When consensus resolutions are factored in as votes identical to those of the United States, a much higher measure of agreement with U.S. positions is reached - 85.4 percent, up slightly from 84.3 percent in 2009.

## TABLES SHOWING COMPARISON WITH U.S. VOTES

The tables that follow are based on the 71 instances the United States voted either Yes or No in Plenary. Columns show the number of times the United States and the pertinent country cast identical (Yes/Yes or No/No) and opposite ( $\mathrm{Yes} / \mathrm{No}$ or $\mathrm{No} / \mathrm{Yes}$ ) votes, as well as the number of times a country abstained or was absent for these 71 votes. Voting coincidence percentages are derived by dividing the number of identical votes by the total of identical and opposite votes, the same method used in all previous editions of this report. The column headed "Voting Coincidence (Including Consensus)" presents the percentage of voting coincidence with the United States after including consensus resolutions as additional identical votes. Extent of participation was also factored in (see Introduction: Format and Methodology).

All countries are listed alphabetically.
