"ONE REPORT, APPARENTLY BASED ON INFORMATION FROM EGYPTIAN SOURCES, SAID THAT THE EGYPTIAN ARMY'S FIRST OBJECTIVE WAS TO GRAB TERRITORY AS FAR AS ABOUT 20 MILES DEEP IN THE SINAI, POSSIBLY INCLUDING THE VITAL MOONTAIR PASSES, AND TO HOLD THIS GROUND UNTIL THE U.N. SECURITY COUNCIL OR PRESSURE FROM THE BIG POWERS COULD BRING A CEASEFIRE.
