French have just informed us that they understand Ben Gurion-Fronidzi meeting arranged for Brussels Friday. Israel and Argentine Officials are in direct contact and all remains now is to fix hour.

Foreign Office states that in view of this no need for Security Council Meeting tomorrow. They understand Italians have been asked by US, UK and French to take initiative in suggesting postponement but that Italian UN Representative has not yet received instructions.

French wonder if Italians hesitate whether other third country such as Ecuador could not take initiative.

De Carbonnel states instructions re Ecuadorian initiative have been sent Berard and in conversation yesterday with Argentine Minister he also suggested using Ecuador in some such role.
