

Representatives of the Palestine Liberation Organization (PLO) and the Government of the State of Israel, represented by President Mahmoud Abbas in his capacity as chairman of the PLO executive committee, and Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, meeting at [_____] under the auspices of President Barack Obama of the United States of America, and with the support of [_____] , and determined to bring an end to bloodshed, sorrow, and decades of conflict, to usher in a new era of peace based on freedom, justice, dignity, respect and mutual recognition, and to propagate a culture of peace and non-violence, have agreed on the following joint document for peace between Palestinians and Israelis.

Israel and the PLO shall negotiate in good faith in order to conclude a treaty, to be concluded within 24 months of agreeing to this joint document, with an active American role, providing a just resolution to all aspects of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict, including all core issues (Jerusalem, Borders, Settlements, Refugees, Security, Water, Release of Prisoners) based on the agreed terms of reference and principles herein, including the Roadmap, as endorsed by UNSC Resolution 1515, which embodied the vision of two states and called for an end to the Israeli occupation that began in 1967, the Arab Peace Initiative of 2002, international law, the establishment of a sovereign State of Palestine living side by side in peace and security with the state of Israel on the 1967 borders with agreed swaps, and all relevant UN resolutions, including UNSC Resolutions 242, 338, 1397 and UNGA Resolution 194.

Both sides are committed to commence immediately the parallel implementation of their obligations emanating from the Roadmap. The United States, on behalf of the Quartet, shall be the judge and monitor of the mutual implementation. It should be noted that both sides will continue to honor their commitment to all ongoing obligations under the Roadmap.
