Statement affirming commitment to the two-state vision; calling for an immediate end to violence against Palestinians	Failed
An end to incitement against Palestinians by all official Israeli institutions	Failed
To take no action undermining trust, including deportations, attacks on civilians, confiscation and/or demolition of Palestinian homes and property, and destruction of Palestinian institutions and infrastructure	Failed
Facilitating travel of Palestinian officials for PLC and Cabinet sessions, for security retraining, and for other reform activity	Failed
Facilitating Task Force election assistance, registration of voters, and movement of candidates and voting officials; supporting NGOs involved in the election process.	Partially implemented
Reopening Palestinian Chamber of Commerce and other closed Palestinian institutions in East Jerusalem	Failed
Taking measures to improve the humanitarian situation	Failed
Immediately dismantling settlement outposts erected since March 2001	Failed
Freezing all settlement activity (including natural growth) as per Mitchell Report	Failed
