PRELIMINARY THOUGHTS ON PROCESS (4 October 2007)

A. Current Palestinian Thinking

- 1. Pre-November (SE's "new DNA")
 - Bilateral "decisions" by Leaders on core (permanent status) issues.
 - Appoint drafting teams to devise FAPS/Agreed Principles ahead of Nov. 15th.
 - Sign/endorse FAPS/Agreed Principles at November 15th meeting and agree on a timeline for CAPS.
 - No 3rd Party role.
- 2. Post-November
 - CAPS negotiations begin immediately after November/ conference (*i.e.*, after FAPS/Principles) and concluded within 6 months.
 - Intensive 3rd Party role in all spheres.
- 3. Missing Elements
 - Understanding relationship between process and substance.
 - Focus on modalities for implementing settlement freeze.
 - Internal capacity (security, reform, etc.).
 - Communication strategy.
 - Coordination among various 3rd Party actors (*e.g.*, Dayton, Blair, Rice, etc.).

B. Current Israeli Thinking

- 1. Pre-November
 - Bilateral discussions by Leaders to explore all issues, including core PS issues.
 - Appoint drafting teams to devise joint *general* statement ahead of Conference (November date "not sacred").
 - Conditions for discussions on general statement:
 - must take place in the region;
 - must be held in total secrecy;
 - must not result in "declaration of principles".
 - No 3rd Party role.
- 2. Post-November
 - Discussion of core PS issue only *after* November conference (no time ceiling).
 - Implementation of future PS agreement subject to full implementation of Roadmap Phase I.
 - No (or limited) 3rd Party role.

C. Issues / Questions for Discussion

- 1. What is the current process?... Is it effective? Why or why not?
- 2. What are requirements for a successful conference (for Pal's, Israel, USA, etc.)?
- 3. What are key interests/objectives of main players, both internal (PLO, Hamas, etc.) and external (Israel, USA, EU, Saudi, Syria, Egypt, Jordan, etc.) vis-à-vis Nov. conference?
- 4. What is the current level of Palestinian coordination with key Arab states? What roles should Arab states play prior to / after the Nov. conference?
- 5. What roles should other 3rd Parties (USA, EU, Quartet, Blair, etc.) play prior to / after the Nov. conference?
- 6. What needs to happen between FAPS/Principles Agreement and CAPS? What should be the deadline for achieving a CAPS?
- 7. How will Israeli actions vis-à-vis Gaza (military attacks, embargo, collective punishment, etc.) affect the process?
- 8. How does Palestinian unity/disunity affect the process? (At what stage, if at all, must there be reconciliation?)
- 9. What should be the relationship between the various 3rd Party "technical" envoys (Dayton, Blair, etc.)?
- 10. How do you ensure a process that is based on *parallel*—as opposed to *conditional*—implementation?
- 11. What is the relevance of the Roadmap in this new process?
